



Benefits for UCC Faith Formation Employees

Those employed by the United Church of Christ in educational ministries may be eligible to participate in Pension Boards benefits programs, even if working part time. These benefits include a tax-sheltered annuity, the UCC Health Plan, and others. Enrolling in any Pension Boards benefit enables individuals to receive free financial counseling and planning from Ernst & Young, another vital element in nurturing long-term financial security.

While the employment circumstances of those working in educational ministries varies widely, the nature of employment in the denomination is changing for all, and the Pension Boards is working to adapt to meet the needs of those who may not be employed by the UCC for an entire career, or who desire portability when leaving UCC employment.
